Pleasanton Garbage Service: Keeping the Community Clean and Green

P leasanton Garbage Service (PGS) has been proudly serving both residential and commercial locations in Pleasanton for decades. As a locally owned and operated business, PGS considers the community part of its expanding family. The company understands that the issues and concerns affecting residents also impact them, driving their commitment to exceptional waste management and environmental sustainability.

PGS offers innovative collection programs and has earned the prestigious "Certificate of Sustainability." They actively collaborate with the City of Pleasanton and Alameda County's StopWaste.org to ensure efficient and eco-friendly waste management services.

Comprehensive Waste Disposal and Recycling Services

The Pleasanton Transfer Station accepts all non-hazardous solid waste. However, treated wood is no longer accepted. While most disposal fees are standardized, heavier materials like dirt, concrete, sod, and rock are charged by the ton.

PGS also provides electronic waste recycling, accepting items such as televisions, computers, monitors, printers, and fax machines. A designated drop-off area is available, and fees vary based on the item(s) brought in. Pleasanton Garbage Service, Inc.

The Pleasanton Reuse Trailer

For residents looking to donate gently used items instead of discarding them, PGS offers the Pleasanton Reuse Trailer. Items such as bikes, bed frames, working small appliances, sporting goods, art, and furniture can be donated.

A Legacy of Service

PGS was founded in 1969 by Tony Macchiano and Bob Molinaro, who built the company from the ground up while raising their families in Pleasanton. As the city grew from 12,000 to over 83,000 residents, so did PGS, expanding its services and infrastructure.

The company pioneered waste management innovations, opening Alameda County's first transfer station in 1976. In 1984, they introduced automated collection to improve efficiency and reduce worker injuries. By 1991, PGS established a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) to enhance recycling efforts.

Committed to a Sustainable Future

As waste management challenges evolve, PGS remains dedicated to reducing the waste stream through

recycling and source reduction. The company partners with the Go Green Initiative to promote environmental responsibility. PGS is also an esteemed member of the Pleasanton Chamber of Commerce and has been recognized with the Community Development Award.

The Assistance League of Amador Valley's mission is to transform the lives of children and adults through community programs. As a non-profit, the philanthropic projects of the Assistance League are locally designed – serving Dublin, Pleasanton, and Livermore – and carried out by volunteers who spend thousands of hours annually contributing time and effort to the programs. Assistance League® has several programs that support our mission.

Operation School Bell® -**Clothing the Children**, one of Assistance League's largest programs, provides students with help in purchasing new clothes at the start of the school year. Each child is awarded a fixed dollar amount. Volunteers then guide the child through the process, helping them select their own clothes. The program serves over 400 children every year.



Our **Food for Families** program has been extremely important to families that rely on food donations to make ends meet. We partner with Tri-Valley Haven Food Pantry to purchase and deliver grocery staples twice a week to the pantry, benefiting more than 4,000 lowincome residents each month.

The bags go to Tri-Valley Haven children celebrating a birthday while they are living at a local shelter. Working with the Alameda County Social Services Agency, we supply college-bound foster students with backpacks and essential school supplies through our **Kids in Need** program.
